 Fine sunny day thawing considerable P.M.
 Willie drove down in waggon A.M. got from
 Sargent off car 1270 lbs out at 73 ^{cts} which he took
 to mill to get chaffed then brought up from Sargent's
 car 1860 lbs corn at 120 bushel \$39.85
 Willie gave cheque on I.B. for total \$67.34 chaffing 1.02
 I cut wood in hardwood bush A.M. P.M. we
 set ensilage blower and cut some hay to try it.
 then Willie went down for shop I made camp
 with him. Mary called on Rogersons P.M.
 as Geo is not well yet then she called at Barbours
 then went down home, Willie paid for weighing
 corn 10 cts also for getting kettle etc mended 35 cts

 8 cts Mary came up with him they drove along to Gansco
 and Barbours Mary gave Mrs Barbours \$1.00 to send to
 Belgians. I dug out drain outlets and Willie chaffed
 A.M. P.M. Willie chaffed and I split wood in
 woodshed. Mary and Willie walked down at
 night. Willie got at Phillips 3c press orders
 one 2:27 for Barrel corn \$15.35 Page Wine 94c
 B.A. Oil Co. with orders & stamps 33 cts also got ink 25 cts
 28.15 cheque on I.B. got at Indoles butcher knife
 45 cts at Ross Taylors butchers 30 cts
