- Sat 17 Milk 60. Bread 30. 2 lbs margarine 80. 40^{cts} per lb 1 70 at Enslly McIntyres, at 5 P.M there was very heavy rain. Had a letter from Jimmie. he had an experience. After leaving Russell there was a heavy shower which made the clay very sticky his car slipped in the ditch.

- Sat 17 he went to a farm house, to ask leaf to stay all night. The farmer was living alone and not very tidy (he was a bachelor, next day he took his team and drew out the car and Jimmie "went on his way rejoicing"

- Frid 23 Mary Gore called, she came with Barbara who is taking music lessons from Jimmie McDonald Bought of John Hay McGillis from Glen Factory 1 cheese, 32 lb, 29 p lb 9 28
- Sat 24 In afternoon Far came in on kitchen door went out on hall door said he had Mr & Mrs Adams and two guests Milk 60. bread 30. 3 lbs margarine 1.20 2 10
- Sun 25 General fund 50^{cts}
- Mon 26 Fine and bright, quite cool Muddy went to Montreal. Jimmie to Cornwall Agnes gave me two qrt pints of boiled raspberries on Sunday, 25th
