Sunday, July 9th Showery

Mother & I went to Church
in morning, heard Rev
Crews preach on a "wide
awake Church" col 50
In Afternoon, Tom & Family
came down, & had tea with us

Monday 9th fine

J. W. Cut hay in morning, & W.
Cleaned bot stalls and
bedded them. J. J. hoed some mangel
I went to Hendersons & brought
home E. P. Mayflower 5th & we
killed & buried her. we found her
heart very large & fatty, her liver
very large, hard and rather blue
colored on out side and hard &
dark in side. A great deal of
bloody water around her bowels
& lungs, but did not notice
any Tubercles, or any thing
of that sort the fat under her
skin was more like jelly than
fat. we scuffled & hoed some
turnips.

Tuesday 10th fair heavy shower last night

I went to see about fence
between Simpson place & Thurtell
then went to town sold
hide of heifer \$5²⁰, 5²⁰ \$20
got buggy fixed. 35⁰⁰, paid 35
Jessie \$10⁰⁰ but got 10⁰⁰ 10⁰⁰
we all hoed turnips
finished the first row
Patch got harness. \$2⁵⁰ 2⁵⁰

Wednesday 11th fine

J. W. Cut hay in morning and
we dug out barberry & blasted
a stump. Joe picked & puddled
buro in morning & bedded &
raked in afternoon. I
went to town in morning and
sent \$5⁴⁰ to Farmers Advocate. 5⁴⁰
got dynamite. 20⁰⁰/45 1⁴⁵
