Willie and I went to Mrs Magwoods funeral in P.M. she was buried in Elora cemetery. Willie took the potatoes picked this morning down home also two bags pig chop to Curless 31 lbs got at Mills meat 25 cts. Father up in P.M. for tea.

Fine day sunny exceedingly warm day Willie went down for chop in morning 10 cts we brought up two loads wood from bush. in P.M. Belle Willie and I went to show we let cattle in rape a little while in morning show expenses 50 grapes 20

Exceedingly warm day again I wave some more fuel. Willie cultivated stump field No 7 and harrowed potato land and cultivated it we got about 3 bags potatoes. I went to church in P.M. Mr Horn of Elora preached from text "Who you therefore that believe he is precious." I bought two collars at Geo Woods 25 cts paid Duke Jim for saw sharpening 25 cts
Gins sold to Wm Jackson 2 gals cream \$1.40 I posted letter to Sophia Newton for Mary 2 cts
