**A Suppurating Wound.**

When dressing a freely suppurating wound of one of the extremities it is much better to apply the gauze in flat pads than in circular turns. Soiled gauze wound about an extremity cannot well be removed in a cleanly fashion; and, too, circular turns tend, by spreading the pus over the skin, to set up a pustular dermatitis.—*Amer. Journ. of Surgery.*
