Croton September 1901

- Thu Sept 26<sup>th</sup> clear and hot in the middle of the day. I was helping John cut corn
- Fri Sept 27<sup>th</sup> clear and hot. not doing much
- Sat Sept 28<sup>th</sup> cloudy I was helping Walter husk corn in the fore noon. after noon setting in the house.
- Sun Sept 29<sup>th</sup> cloudy and damp rain most of the night
- Mon Sept 30<sup>th</sup> cloudy fore noon. after noon clear and pleasant. not doing much
- Tue Sept 1<sup>st</sup> cloudy and warm. I went with Walter to Florence.
- Wed Oct 2<sup>nd</sup> cloudy and cool. I dug my few potatoes they were a poor affair
- Thu Oct 3<sup>rd</sup> fall clouds and cold wind I was helping Walter husk in the fore noon after noon not feeling well not doing much
- Fri Oct 4<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cold a sharp frost last night. not doing any thing to day Mahlon Gibson was here this fore noon about seven years since he was here before.

Croton October 1901

- Sat Oct 5<sup>th</sup> clear high wind and cool I went to Florence fair sow but meddling
- Sun Oct 6<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant. Missionary meeting
- Mon Oct 7<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant. I was husking corn for J. B. Smarey
- Tue Oct 8<sup>th</sup> clear and warm. not doing much to day
- Wed Oct 9<sup>th</sup> rain in the morning cloudy the rest of the day not doing any thing to day.
- Thu Oct 10<sup>th</sup> cloudy and soft not doing any thing
- Fri Oct 11<sup>th</sup> heavy fog in the morning the rest of the day clear and warm. was setting the house
- Sat Oct 12<sup>th</sup> cloudy and warm not doing much
- Sun Oct 13<sup>th</sup> cloudy and warm. high wind last night
- Mon Oct 14<sup>th</sup> clear and warm. I was helping J. B. Smarey husk corn.
- Tue Oct 15<sup>th</sup> clear with high wind from South West was husking corn for Walter
- Wed Oct 16<sup>th</sup> rain all day. was setting in the house
- Thu Oct 17<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool not doing much. a few flakes of snow the first here this season
- Fri Oct 18<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool. I was helping Walter this after noon sett up corn stalks
