- Sun Mar 3. Fine very high wind. Aunt Nellie church, I went to ev. church. Slippy.
- Mon Mar 4. Fine bright day, we washed. Mrs Shuter called. Snowed in evening.
- Tue Mar 5. Damp and foggy then rained in evening a little.
- Wed Mar 6. Dull and moderately cold. Aunt Mattie and I in Toronto, got my coat, old one \$75. and new one \$100. paid. I went to Fisherville in eve. snow in eve.
- Thurs Mar 7. Fine and bright. Aunt Mattie went for a little walk.

- Tue Mar 12. Fine mild, slushy, water over. Mrs James buried. I went to Red Cross.
- Wed Mar 13. Mild and thawing, water over. I went back road. Frank bot paper.
- Thurs Mar 14. Biting all day very high water. I went back way.
- Fri Mar 15. Fine very cold, near to zero, still water deep on road.
- Sat Mar 16. Fine moderating, water not over much could walk. I took Frank to Toronto. I went to Park eve. Lizzie called.
