

Monday 2 At home Flawins B^m N^o 5 & A B's were here
 Ap 3 Drove dung W. fine some East wind ^{or} cool clear
 in 4 spread some dung A M I took chop to mill & W
 began plowing fallow P.M. W. shower & sun & another
 M 5 Both plowed in fallow W. fine. Clear north wind
 A B's were here at noon
 A 6 Both plowed A M. W went to A Smiles raising
 on 3rd Con Picking I took my Mother to P D's
 2 She is getting very weak in her mind and body
 7 I washed sheep A M Dave ^{very warm} helped B C plant
 6 Potatoes A M Chored P.M. W. began to rain
 about 10 A.M. rained nearly all day
 8 W went to Flawins loghouse raising on his end of
 lot on 4th Con. I took my Mother to P D's P.M.
 2 Saw Baby, born about noon W. some showers
 1 Sunday 9 We all & my Mother went to B^m N^o 5
 2 were not at home staid for dinner with the
 3 young folks Martha Shank & her man &
 4 Christian Stovers were here at supper Mat
 1 got married this spring to Mr. Cheneser Co
 2 out west in the township of Dorchester W. C
 3 10 Finished plowing fallow & started plowing ^{heavy rain last night} turnip
 ground A M W plowed some P.M. & I went
 to P D's W. fine A M some very heavy rain &
 4 thunder P.M. started water pretty high
 8 11 Saved some rail cut A M boys & A B
 & his boys went fishing P.M. got nothing W
 warm & slight shower this evening
 12 I Planted garden for Flawins at his new house
 A M helped W plow turnip ground P.M. W
 helped Flawins put rafters on his house after
 supper. W. fine warm. Clear
 13 Both plowed in turnip ground till near noon when
 it began to rain. rained nearly all P.M. I shot a
 bird up at dam today which succeeds me to name
 it belongs to the Crane. species I should think
 14 Drove rails out of Percors bush along 5th Con
 nearly to fence it in. I took Nancy & my mother
 to P D's & then went to Mr. Swallows near Duffins creek
 with my bird to get it I suspect it proved to belong

June 14 to the Crane species ¹⁸⁷² but it is commonly called
 or (skitepoker) then I got a keg of beer at the Creek Brewery
 W. warm slight showers P.M. roads heavy
 15 Finished drawing rail out of bush & then drove
 7 loads from B^m N^o 5 W. fine. Clear
 Sunday 16 All went to B^m N^o 5. W. fine Clear
 A B's were here at supper
 17 I & Nancy went to Markham A.M. I went
 to Cherry wood P.M. W. harrowed turnip ground
 Dave had Carl rose Potatoes W. fine Clear
 18 Dave harrowed old fallow W. drove a few rails & then
 began to make turnip drills I helped scrub & wash
 Meeting house P.M. W. fine Clear
 19 Chord A M. sowed about half of turnips
 P.M. Uncle John Burkholder was here at dinner
 20 I & Nancy went to B^m in law Saml ^{W. warm clear} Hoover's his
 wife was confined about a week ago and is
 rather poorly but is getting better I helped B C
 C draw stones W. very very warm. Suddy.
 21 Finished sowing turnips in East half of field East of
 dam about 4 acres & 1 acre of potatoes. A.M. began
 drawing dung on heap in fallow I intend putting
 it on pen ground in field near Hoover's East
 part west part is fallow. W. rather cool
 22 Drove dung. Mother rather poorly getting better
 Sunday 23 I & Nancy staid at home. Meeting at Pebron my
 Mother is pretty bad we have to sit up with her
 all night quite a few visitors. W. fine Clear
 24 boys drove dung I helped to wait on my Mother
 she is very restless. sleeps very little. does a great
 deal. I imagine strange things. and consequently
 takes a great deal of attendance she got a little
 stronger this evening so I gave her a short drive
 in the buggy. W. fine Clear Jacob Bendricks
 & wife were here today with Jael Resor & Alcl
 Saml Neighwelder
 25 waited on my Mother. she is still pretty strong
 Joseph Shirk's were here today. M Dye's little mummy
 died today. W. fine. Clear. looks a little like rain
