Oct. 29<sup>th</sup>

Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> Oct. A Soldier of the 5 Regiment was  
Shot at Niagara for Deserting his post, this is the  
first Execution known here

Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> 2

Left two days Schooling, working on the Road

9. 10. 11

Left 3 days Schooling. bad weather, 1 day, at the  
Funeral of M<sup>r</sup>. Lampmans Child, 1 day & working Road

13<sup>th</sup> Nov<sup>r</sup>

The first Snow this Evening about shoe deep went  
off in two days.

28<sup>th</sup>

An other Snow that went away

Dec. 11<sup>th</sup>

Sold David Secord my white faced Cow  
for £8..0..0.

18<sup>th</sup>

A Snow and begins to fodder Cattle in earnest
