 M^r Samuel Philips excited in W^r W^r Kenney
 rained most of the day Ad went to mill
 with 40 bushel of oats & 5 bushel of corn

 went to Sam. Innes got no work done he

 roller & drag teeth feed downy most
 of the day Cleon went to Innes
 Snowed all day feed the buckets
 no meeting to day very stormy snow
 & wind the roads completely black up
