Monday	March 12	A lovely day. Went to bridge at Hilda's – got prize – vase.
Tuesday	March 13	Grand day. Went to a bridge at Janet Rumble's – got prize – writing paper. Nice time.
Wednesday	March 14	A beautiful day – summy & warm. Sidewalks all bare. Clara & I visited Jean Steeds in aft. – she scalded her leg with boiling water. Irla & I had sundae in Chinamen's at night.
Thursday	March 15	A grand day – Lorne graduated as air gunner today. Very warm. Not a speck of snow anyplace now. Com. meeting at night & I went to Grant's afterwards.

Friday	March 16	Very warm & bright – warmest March day in 100 years. Went to Auxiliary concert – old time social – old dresses, coats, hats & shawls modelled & antiques on display. Real good.
Saturday	March 17	Raining. Went home after work.
Sunday	March 18	A lovely day. Fire at Chronicle office. Read & knitted. Visited Anna & Uncle Will after church. Lorne came home at night. Sgt. now. Interviewed for Com. but told too young.
Monday	March 19	Raining. I had 2 letters from Laddie. Went to bridge at Berniece's.
Tuesday	March 20	Busy. Went to Red Cross. Ate at Chinamen's after.
Wednesday	March 21	A nice day but cool. I had girls in at night so was terribly busy all aft. – ten girls. Vera got prize. Served sandwiches (ham, tomato, egg, salmon) & fruit torte. Lorne helped me with dishes.
Thursday	March 22	A grand day. Went to Clara's for evening. Ruth & Irla there.
Friday	March 23	American Armies crossed Rhine. A lovely day. Unemp. Ins. Auditor here. Had my hair done. Went to Irla's afterwards.
Saturday	March 24	A beautiful warm spring day. Laddie 30 - Wrote him. <u>Six</u> <u>armies across Rhine</u> . Laddie on <u>Western Front now</u> – got word to-day, landed Mar. 5 th . Irla, Norma, Betty, Don, Lorne & I went to Owen Sound – supper, shopped, show – "Thirty Seconds Over Tokyo" – swell. Bought brown oxfords & purse.
Sunday	March 25	A perfect day. Fowler's here – 6 of them. Norma went back on six bus. Read at night.
Monday	March 26	Grand day. Allied armies making wonderful progress east of Rhine. Cleaned clothes closet, etc., at night.
Tuesday	March 27	Perfect day: very warm. Cleaned dresser drawers after work. Red Cross & Chinamen's after. Finished boxes – have sent to all Durham boys overseas.
Wednesday	March 28	A beautiful day. Did a big washing. Clara & I went over town. Clara & I went to Zilliax's at night. Afterwards Irla called & asked me over for lunch.
Thursday	March 29	A little cooler. Irla & I went up to Rumble's for game of bridge (a hot cross bun for lunch). Bob drove me home afterwards.
Friday	March 30	Good Friday. Nice day. I came up town in aft. with Lorne – visited Irla & Barb & Anna. Read, etc. at night. Marg Derby called. Vera, Jean & Reg home for awhile.
Saturday	March 31	Raining but cleared in aft. Vera & Reg home. I went home after work. Wrote Laddie.
Sunday	April 1	Easter Sunday – a very nice day. Lorne & I went to Knox in morning (church full), to Bogle's in aft. & to Varney church at night. I went to Irla's afterwards.

Saturday	April 7	Very busy. Went home after work. Finished white cardigan.
Sunday	April 8	A beautiful day. Went to Toronto with Barb, Lloyd & Ethel – ½ an hr. to get ready. Arrived at 2. Barb & I ate at Murray's. Went to hospital to see Anna. Ate at Chicken Palace, then I went up to Sally's – played bridge.
Monday	April 9	Sally & I went down town at nine. Shopped Bloor & Yonge, saw Vera, lunch at Georgian room. I got a coral suit, lime green blouse & hat – wine Borsalino felt, made up at Town Shop on Adelaide. Went to Shea's – Bing Crosby in "Here Come The Waves" – good. Got train to Ceylon at 6. Lorne met me at 9:25.
Tuesday	April 10	A beautiful day. 2 letters from Laddie. Straightened out finances, etc., in morning. Wrote him. Wally & Florence have son – born yesterday. Went to Red Cross. Irla came over after to see my things.
Wednesday	April 11	Busy in morning. Had my hair done & went to Auxiliary Thank-offering supper. Mission Band put on program. Went to a bridge party at Rumble's after – 2 tables.
Thursday	April 12	Nice day. Had 4 letters from Laddie – he is in Holland now. <u>President Roosevelt died suddenly</u> – a great statesman. Our Red Cross dance – cleared \$80.
Friday	April 13	Real busy – tired. Hectic week just flew. Lorne wanted me to go to show in Hanover with him & Madeline – 2 features.
Saturday	April 14	Cooler. Trout fishing season opened. Wrote Anna a long letter. Prs. Roosevelt's funeral. Went to a farewell party for Janet at Irla's – nice time.
Sunday	April 15	Cool but nice. Went to church in the morning – communion. Jean joined. Went home after. Radio programs lively last 3 days in commemoration of president Roosevelt – no advertising, all sacred music. Lorne went away on 6 o'clock bus. Wrote letters & read at night.
Monday	April 16	Raining & real windy. Busy. I stayed in at night & did odd jobs.
Tuesday	April 17	Very windy & cool. Had 4 nice letters from Laddie. Went to Auxiliary – took sandwiches. Eunice & I went in with Irla afterwards.
Wednesday	April 18	Cool. Wrote Laddie. Jack McGowan came home – lost an eye in Italy. Anna came home from hospital to-day for another month's rest before she can have operation.

Thursday	April 19	Windy. Lorne came home – was released temporarily. I

Thursday	April 26	Snowing. The San Francisco World Security Conference opened to-day in San Francisco – delegates from all allied nations have gathered to plan how to keep the peace. Freda had a 2(?) lb. son. I went to show in Mt. Forest with Jack, Clara & Kay – saw "None But the Lonely Heart".
Friday	April 27	Busy. Wrote Laddie. The Br., American & Russian troops have met in heart of Germany. Irla & I went to show in Hall – saw Cary Grant & Irene Dunne in "Penny Serenade". Ate at Irla's.
Saturday	April 28	Cool but bright. Norma Taylor has son. 90% of Berlin captured by Russians. A false rumour that Germans had surrendered unconditionally came over air.
Sunday	April 29	Bright but cool. Came up in aft. as Lorne was going to Fry's for supper. Wrote Laddie, went to church. Visited at Grant's at night.
Monday	April 30	Cool. I got a permanent at Ethel's. Norma Taylor's baby boy died yest. – double pneumonia - buried to-day.
Tuesday	May 1	A few flurries of snow. Jimmy Wilson was killed overseas. Went to Com. meeting & to Irla's after. Myrtle Mortley was there – telling us about Norma's baby.
Wednesday	May 2	Berlin fell to Russians; Germans in Italy & Austria surrendered unconditionally – a great day. Had letters from Laddie. Went up to hospital to see Freda in aft. She thinks she will call baby "John". Went to Barb's at night. Played bridge. Norman home.
Thursday	May 3	Had letters from Laddie. Read at night.
Friday	May 4	Dull & cold. <u>Wonderful news to-day</u> – Germans in Holland, Denmark & Northwestern Germany have surrendered unconditionally – where Canadians are fighting. Irla came over at night. Jean, Nora & Stella too – had lunch & talked.

Saturday	June 2	Very cold. Busy. Had letter from Laddie. 15 Lancasters on way home – Goose Squadron. We are hoping Elgin will be in one of the planes landing to-morrow.
Sunday	June 3	Cool. Read most of day. Planes not coming for a few days – delayed due to adverse weather.


