very Bad with Sicks took her out of the Muds 23rd found the
very full of Sicks Lashy and Me taking them of Harrowing
above the house for corn some grains of Snow fell saw a
Steamer coming out of Salmon River very unwell today
Planted 5 Quarts of Corn it was so aged well when I planted
George wind Bound on CBSIS Island came at night
24th Birth Day Fired 8 or 10 Volleys took 4 Bushels of Potatoes for
seed 1 Bushel of Wheat the Harrow and L. arnes 25th sowed
1 1/2 Bushels of Wheat Fixing the colt set Lashy line Charlie came
took up some seeds different kinds Charlie and I to Williamston
took out 5 lb of sugar 1 Bottle of Syrup 1 cake to Franzy 1 to
John of Ellens girls 1 to Ellens 3 lbs Georges colt dead went to
see Pat John Angus got hurted the Queens Birth Day seen
John Lickeress 26th came home stopt at Lancaster sent Charlie
for Onions got a Quart of Potatoe onions for a Quart seen John Dunlop
soft Breakfast on sways Island sowed a pail full of
wheat I had in the house alongside of Georges wheat sowed
Georges Pease 1 Bushel sowed 2 Bushels of my Pease George
measured them Mr Ladulle here took Breakfast gave Livina
Lashy went away with Ladulle Betsy Bone came Sheared
Big Man

Sunday George went home sent him canoe sail over
high East Wind Raining this evening Linnia sick let out
sheep that is sheared 8 of them 2 in yet to be sheared
28th Sheared the 2 sheep with the lambs George came Lashy
crossed this evening 29th George trying to plough with the scow
Found an ear 30th planted the Cucumbers and Melons 31st
corpus Christe planted 2 Bushels of our seed ends of the Potatoes
Lashy and me Luke Bowen and Betsy came to let George
know about the scow George crossed Luke got a
Large Sturgeon from Lashy Fixing sticks around from
Butternut tree to the gate planted some Runkins among the Potatoes
1st of JUNE the glorious 1st of June How
Victory Frost last night Charlie and I to Williamston
with the Wool 33 lb of Wool 5 cakes of sugar to the Boyar
Hugham pickled cucumbers grapes and currants 2 eels
Went to see Ellen got a pair of young Rabbits
from Ellen got some stuff in a Bottle from Ellen
got some --- seen Pat Bought of James Summers
5 cents of Thread a Great Thomas and Jonell
seen A Campbell and Rob. andy Smith Bob
Dingies came with us very unwell coming home
Charlie went home tonight 2nd of June Harrowing
and sowing 1 1/2 Bushels of Pease that's 3 1/2 of
my Pease that's sowed, and 1 Bushel of George
which makes 4 1/2 in all sowed of Pease John Angus
and I went to fish at night got 1 Mastinonge 1 Sturgeon
3 lbs 2 suckers 2 perch 1 cat fish 3rd Sunday a time
no Boats going to day got some Wild Onions in the Bush
4th George the 3rd Birth Day John Angus crossed
Lashy Raining put in some Potatoes around the corner
door clearing the corn 5th Lashy crossed got a paper from
Harper for me making a Box to hold his minnow
in 16 hills of squashes at the east end of the Bush in 5th Independence
and lightning very hard Raining the fields all of garden
Rain letting the water Run off Lashy killed 18 geese
to fetch to Montreal
