Tut hills 37 cents got 2 almanacks at Tut hills
10 cent 11 cents for Whiskey Bought of A. Morris
1 Quart Whisky 1/4 1 lb Sugar 1/2 1 lb Tea
2/3 Bought of A. Morris 1 Broom 1/6
The Prince of Wales married to say
Firing at night Mr Henderson came
with me to thash 11th Stormy time I went
to Williamstown brought cat pet stuff
1 keg of Eels 1 bag of milk got the Bag I

Bought of A. Summers 1 Bar soap
1 1/2 7 annis the last of the Wheat 2 Bushels
chopping some stone wood Henderson the Pigeon
Gone off (Gone) This Day Mr Master came
to the Island first 13th gave an Order
to Henderson on a Summers for 3/9
14th got a Rat knocking about waiting these
Days see if they were coming for the
15th Hay cold night the cattle all well
Sunday a cold morning ^{a strange Bury on the top of the Barn} freezing very hard
but a fine Day 16th a very cold morning But
a most Beautiful Day it is, cut one 3/4 hole
and stop at that the Ice is so very thick
very near 3 Feet in Thickness forced my
Spear made a hole for another nail Drew home
2 Loads of Wood with the Mare the Wolf
On the Island a dog on his track Sunday 17th
Stormy snowing West Wind at a true 8/3 and a stormy
Day it is waiting for them to come for the hay Set
2 Trap in Back Part of the Island either a Rat
or a Hunt hole that 5 Traps I have set 4 pulls
out 18th Went to Salmon River to settle affairs
Brought some traps to Bills horse him dead. Saw
old David Summers & John Cameron there
took me to Coles Tavern and treated well
to 2 Treats at Coles 1 at Normans 1 at Bakers
paid Norman for the Broom came home
started with the Boy Gordon to Morris
took the short Road at a Lewis Island 19th went
to Mr Webb's & to the Presbyterian at Paddocks
Bought of A. Ellen married on the 18th
