## The Care of Surgical Patients-No. 1.

The afternoon previous to the day of operation, the patient should receive 2 ounces of castor oil in beer and a light evening meal. A tub bath should be given, especial care being taken to avoid chilling, and the field of operation shaved. In the morning the lower bowel and rectum should be thoroughly evacuated by enemata when the preparation for the operating room is complete. This simple routine applies to the large percentage of surgical cases, while special conditions require special measures.—Balfour; Mayo Clinic, Med. Record.
