Fine in A.M. very heavy thunder shower in P.M. strong wind and heavy hail which did considerable damage Brown's barn was struck by lightning and burnt. Mr McVicar preached in A.M. from 1<sup>st</sup> commandment and in evening from text In all things he was tempted like as we are yet without sin. Auntie Mrs Sandham and Norman in p.dinner.

8 Monday

Fine sunny most day cloudy morning cool. Bella and Willie went up to J. McSelleans and back with Jeth in buggy I plowed in beets stump field. Charlie Ferguson called in P.M.

9 Tuesday

Fine sunny day. cool. 7<sup>th</sup> at least night Willie plowed all day in stump field I scuffled turnips. Dougal hoeing turnips in P.M. Uncle Willie and Walter Cameron left horse here on road to Gt. I went down town in P.M. got meat at Mills 5<sup>7</sup> bread at foots 12 separator oil at Nichols 15 got harness mended at McDemmitts gave Father cheques for Base topay for loads and side delivery rake \$10.50 Sold cream to Jackson \$1.00 We got butter cheque to-day 13<sup>57</sup>
