16	Friday forward Raining more or less all day not very heavy. I went up to station for 3 bags balled wire etc in A.M. Willie down town in P.M. got at Lemplins stuff for dashboard 35 cts got Kettle mended at Kears 10 cts. Soap 10 cts Willie drove Mary down to Mrs Robertsons see Mrs Ritchie tea party. 17	Saturday Cloudy in A.M. cleared off fine sunny P.M. exceedingly warm. Willie plowed turnip land in A.M. and I put back wire out on along O.S.R. No. 1. In P.M. we drilled up and sowed 20 more rows turnips. Father up for tea Willie down town in P.M. also at night got at Stals 3 1/2 lbs Good Luck turnip seed 70 at Hunting salmon 15 postage 2		87
18	Sunday Exceedingly warm day sunny. Mr McVicar preached in A.M. from Exo ds. 34:35. a sermon to teachers of S.S. and in evening a sermon on play of children one text from Lam. hungry children on top of streets one in Jez. happy children playing in streets of Jerusalem Uncle Geo and Aunt Maggie Dodge down stayed at home all night.		
19	Monday Very warm day cloudy and sunny. rained a shower at noon. I worked turnip land and made 16 drills after tea. Willie down town on wheel got at Mells meat 25 cts		25
