Marjorie went to Elgin I churned. made two custard pies. little sponge cakes & jelly tarts. swept & cleaned the dining room & dusted it swept & cleaned the kitchen & all the boards. swept the yard. Marjorie took 3 doz eggs & 24 lbs butter the total 3 lb to Juv Day for 25 per lb. 10<sup>th</sup> commercial bacon & March 10 cheese. can corn 10. 5 loaves bread 8. Will sick all day. at night he & Lulu went down to the doctor terrible hot. got cool at night. The youngsters guarded the cows morning & night.

Jennie came home with Marjorie Sat 10. Frank Rieinger helping Arthur draw in hay raking on their place easier then the snow wind feels like a storm. Jennie & I went to Rieingers in the afternoon Hattie & Ethel Miller came on the lake from town after noon. Hattie & I went to Rieingers Arthur went after them in the night there was a thunder storm over but off. the rain after the rain but not enough falling dinner he went before supper fans went over there. Marjorie went with them Tom brought Ethel home Arthur walked up & rode back with the girls Arthur took started the rain on the night to gently & nice & cold.

Mon 12. I churned & worked the butter for fans 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  for the pink we got from her. I picked a little bunch of cherries & the children picked the rest & I packed them enough to fill 5 qts & imperial at that. Marjorie took fans in the station & it was threatening a storm I got the work done cows milked milk separated & came so suddenly lightning was just dreadful so close it scared her till the house I was so upset about her not being home the children went up to open the gate when she got home. Hattie came out & Arthur had helped to unhares & stayed until she was well. Will was down to see the doctor & got as far as Newton Arthur finished cutting opposite the house 13 Will raked what was cut sat. I made aJohnny cake for dinner.

Tue 13. they cultivated their potatoes Marjorie worked I hoed our potatoes towards night. I canned the cherries there was 5 jars.

Wed 14 Marjorie finished her washing. I churned & canned a pail of water from the school house. Hattie Rieinger called she wanted salt. Hattie raking they drewed hay loads here & put on the stack & then took hay

Thur 15 Marjorie. the children & Hattie went after cherries Marjorie got 20 qts & Hattie 17. Arthur mowing. I made a Johnny cake for supper had fried ham I could not make up my mind to kill a hen. thundered bared leaves I was afraid there would be a storm before they got home I washed a lot of my clothes that was laying around high wind about whipped the clothes in pieces we picked the cherries before we went to bed.

Friday 16. I canned up part of the cherries in the afternoon as I got a kettle ready to can I had to go to town away it threatened a storm just as I got out of the mo-
