The Relief of Gas Pains After Appendicectomy.

In fifteen successive cases, Kenefick has obtained complete relief by the following method: He administers 20 grains of acetyl salicylic acid ester, with five grains of bicarbonate of soda and one grain of calomel, in two or four ounces of water the afternoon preceding the operation. This is followed by an enema the next morning. The dose varies with the age of the patient. If signs of distension appear after the operation, ten grains can be given the next day.—*Kenefick; New York Med. Journ.*
