Stanley and I cutting saw logs snowed  
on Trail Lewis the Indian here, to  
Dinner gave him a Peice of meat  
to take home, some cakes for the  
children. Treated him to wine & no  
Raining Thaled E Wind Fusing the  
crosscut saw 3<sup>rd</sup> Allen's Bay 1891  
Windy Fine 4<sup>th</sup> Cold W Wind Drew  
some of the saw logs to the Bank Frosty  
tonight The Heifer calved Spotty 5<sup>th</sup>  
very cold and frosty W Wind not  
making much ice at the Porush  
Fence splitting stove wood 6<sup>th</sup>  
Ephary not very well E Wind  
Snowing Blowing hard Killed the  
calf for the skin cold 7<sup>th</sup> W Wind  
some ice going down to the Sturgeon  
Island last night, and from Lancaster  
over to Charles and Ross's Island not  
making much to day took in the Water  
Barrel to the House put in the sheep  
some snow man 8<sup>th</sup> Hugh Ovens  
Birth Day 1886 Drew some wood E Wind  
The Ice came on the Island tonight  
Ice tatten across at the Foot of Francis  
Island Water Raising at the Shore  
9<sup>th</sup> W Wind cutting stove wood Stanley  
and I went around the Island  
seen the Ice on the Sturgeon Island  
10<sup>th</sup> Fine Ice Making 11<sup>th</sup> W Wind  
Cold Windy got 2 rats sawing stove  
wood
