Frost last night cool sunny windy day. Willie took 1 40 lbs cow and horse chop down AM brought load wood manure from tracks we spread it No 7 then he went down for chop took sheepskin (skins) down to Louie Howard got 50¢ for it paid 25 for whiffles. I let water off south field AM. PM Willie took to A Armstrongs 14 1/2 bags potatoes @ 65 per bag \$9.44 12 doz eggs @ 17 \$2.04 on c/c got at Melod paint brush 25 machine oil 10 brought another load manure from tracks I spread it No 7 PM I finished plowing No 7 stump field and disked some. Willie plowed few rows green crop land. Mr Gars over at night for milk paid on 7th Paid me Miss Robson rail c/c \$2.50. W. Clark c/c got 4 doz eggs @ 17 68¢. Saturday culled this morning.

Fine sunny day got quite warm by PM we let our sheep and 22 lambs out to pasture to-day. Willie plowed green crop land No 7 and I disked No 7 stump field changed off with E Ford and helped Jim with 4 loads manure. PM Willie harrowed No 2 then came and harrowed green crop land I spread small load manure from wagon (Fry & Mand) then plowed green crop land. Mary down town PM took R.A. money to Miss Peters gave 30¢ extra sent to Adena Christie fund 400 postage 5- gave to mother 50¢ got at Phillips stamp 10 swamp mallow 15¢ tub on cow meal Hartman 45- got at Stebs on c/c goods \$4.85. Land is wet yet lots of farmers have out started to seed yet. J. Allens man Johnstone moved down again to-day
