Fine sunny warm, clouded over by evening thunder & lightning and heavy shower. Mr. Bobbrow over helping with manure. A.M. we spread of loads on No 3.8. finishing it and also our manuring for this season. We finished cultivating corn and drilling up for turnips including the laded down manure drills we also sowed most of the turnips I was stopped by rain from finishing after tea. Geo Douglas brought over disk harrow P.M. Mr Carter our photographer here in auto A.M. took photo of home and Mary, Willie, & Flo. he is going around taking pictures of houses etc. Norman Byers in A.M. asking us to go to his raising to-morrow.

## Thursday

Mostly cloudy sunny at both ends rained considerable P.M. I drove down with Willie Lucy in buggy took cream down to Russells got assortment of lead that was left at 7.0.8. we drove to Byers but the bean raiser had not got there so we came back went up to Moffatt place to look at it sent letter to J. Beattie offering £12.50 I cultivated with outaway disk some of No 3A Willie chopped some. P.M. Willie drove me to raising at Byers. He drove Mary down town got at Russells 2.5.15 paid J. Woods in full for goods got including 2.50 for my hat 5.15 she paid Russells up in full. £5.35 Charlie Byers fell down and hurt his head and lost his memory for some time
