 1 lb Sugar 1/2 Treats 1/3 1 1/4 10 1/2 in chair for Gordon Nothing
 12th This is the Date Mr. Master first came to the Island
 Linn & Lis here 13th Sunday Linn & Lis crossed a Quail at
 Linn Dan Summers & Bile & Laurie 14th I went to Bill
 Bee Charlie went to Mr Harpers stop a 1/2 sugar
 15th Renshaws Horses crossed to Salmon River & came
 home Met Donald Summers on the ice ^{seen 3 wild geese on the ice hole} cordling some
 Beech 16th Cordling most done Tipoo came from Charlies 17th
 Patricia I went to Mr Harpers brought home his Bottle Bought
 Bottle of oil 1 quart Whiskey Treats Bought of Molland calico 2 yds 3/ - 2 yds
 2/3 red Powder 1/10 gave an order to him on harper for 4-5 1/4 Took home
 2 of the chains a Team crossed 18th Went for the other 4 chairs
 of a Made from John Hamilton Treats at Harpers Lots a crossing
 seen R Buchanan Keepe of Bought of Kolland for the ad
 amount of Calico all clear now

 Drawing Wood Peeling some wood ^{not married yet}
 Claussa Bone to be Married to Day 20th
 Sunday Blustering Palm Sunday snow
 cutter crossed to Hoop the day all done
 on the east side of the Barn Feeding the hens no egg
 got 21st about or on these days the equinoctial gales
 sun crossing the line spring time now 21st went to
 christies all away cutting stove wood 22nd
 Livinia's Birth Day, Drawing wood to the house
 23rd cutting Nails & spoils for fence Campbell came told me
 about young Donald Summers being buried yesterday
 Departed I suppose on the 20th of the Morris here
 told us Emmanuel's child died on the 5th Sap not
 running Freezing hard food going on the Ice 24th
 a Fortunate Day Monday Thursday the day before
 food Friday Livinia & Ellen crossed went forp Linn
 the Boy & Me a low a Fine Day great crossing to
 and from Summers Feeding food Hay this sometime
 to the Court Livinia came 25th food Friday I went to
 Tom Kennedys with the chain Bought of Mr Harpers
 1 quart & pint of Mr. Nipos Brown 1/2 Sugar 1/2 Treat 1/2
 Paul so a Bad Fall of the sleigh on the ice cut hind end
 took home ^{one any 13 of here} a pail of soft Maple Sap Made syrup of it
 is the first new sugar this year Sept 10 Trees with the auger
 26th Went to Salmon River Bought of P. Buchanan all shot
 15 cent pail Bought of Baker 2 Lash 25 cents 1 pair
 of Bridges & screws 10 cents a Gun Lock 2 Boxes of Caps 10 cents
 Bells Buying a Cow Got a piece of a Chain from
 Bill ice getting Bad but crossing got some Balls
 from Bob Blackbirds came some geese & ducks
 Charlie here not very well 27th Easter Sunday Charlie
 went home gave him some caps Buckshot cream Oats geese Tea
 ice opened where I crossed yesterday Wild Geese plenty sailed
 But no fresh ones
