Fiona's Birth Day 1883 Fine Day this Morning
Very foggy cleared off East Wind got 2 Rats 1 in
the Bay and 1 in the Boathouse Tying the corn-
stalks 1st Quarter of the Moon this Afternoon at about
4 o'clock Stanley and Fernandez went to Lancaster for
Cabbages and Scantling took 2 Boats 2nd East Wind
Very foggy this Morning Clabbering the East End
of the Kitchen Stanley Drawing Stones from around
the House to the Bank the 2 Livinias went to
see Adelaide to Kershaws took 20 Doz of Eggs
a very Fine Day Lucies for Butter 2 Men has a
Line set out here Dan Spink here going to So-
Lemays with Sturgeon him and Leander got 5
Dollars for them Fernandez crossed a Letter
Minnie 3rd a Fine Day clabbering Boiling
Potatoes for the Pigs an Indian for Butter
Peeling apples and Stringing them Drawing
Stones from around the House Planted
Grape seed up in the Bay at the Root of
the ugly Elm at the Ditch a very Fine
set the Line caught Minnows Set 4 Traps
in the Boat house for Rats as they are
making free with the corn Fernandez
crossed to night Received a Letter from
John Cameron Junction City Kansas
with 2 Dollars in it to pay for the
Carriage of the Potatoes that I am going
to send him Yum Kipper Day 4th
October 4 in Bottles got a Sturgeon and
a very Large Eel But a very small Scargo got
a Rat Finished the clabbering of the Kitchen
Boiling Potatoes for the Squeal Meats
a very Fine Day Fernandez to Lancaster
I sent for R R R 25 cents Fiona went to see
Adelaide at Kershaws

James Cameron Island 5th of October 1900
Fine Day Rain some Thunder this Morning
Boiling Potatoes for the Pigs Working at the
House Put 2 Loads of Corn stalks in the
North end of the stable Soft Thunder this
afternoon wrote a Letter to John Cameron
Junction City Kansas U.S.A. Killed 2
Roosters Heavy Thunder and Lightning heavy Rain
to night high East wind Fernandez did not
cross with the Letter too Windy 6th E Wind Rain
a Few Drops Working at the House Peeling apples
and Stringing them put in the 2 Rats to night
Fernandez crossed for the Mail took the Letter
But it wont leave till Monday Lady Smith
Went up and then went down Took a Fine
sack of Salt home 7th Fine Day West Wind Leander to
night church Gathered Butternuts Rained hard to
night Fernandez crossed to night 8th Raining to day
took Brick over to the house all 3 working at
the House got a Rat in the Boathouse Churning
Succoth 9th Fine East Wind Sen 27 Wild Geese
Lots of Ducks Flying Fixing up the Thrashing Mill
Putting out Manure with the Canoe Wrote
2 Letters to Day 1 to the Glasgowian with 1 Dollar
in it The other to Publishers Pets and Animals
44 Gortwald Bldg. Springfield, Ohio, U.S.A. 50c
Killed 2 Chickens put Manure in upper field
Fernandez crossed with the Letters gave him money
to pay for them and registered the one for Ohio
Bought Kerosene oil 10th H. A. Birth Day
Fine Cool Fixing at the Mill Making a Blind
out on the Shoal Stanley pulling out Manure
Took the Pumpkins out of the Cornfield took up all
out of the Garden put the Pigs in the Garden Eddy
here for the Gun St Dennis Day took 10 Doz of Eggs
to Doughetta
