- 12 Ad went to Furnisfalls for shingles got 5000

came here this afternoon fine day
- 13 Ad went to a bee of W P Hoers to draw wood  
from McKeemes Betsey & Mr Ewell here today
- 14 Ad went with Stump Young to Reeds for  
a load of cedar posts
- 15 went to Alexandra Bay for Mr
