Wed Feb 8th clear and cold. was thrashing peas. Walter was attending the stock.

Thu Feb 9th clear and very cold. 10 deg below zero this morning. we was cleaning up peas and putting up a load of peas and oats to get chopt.

Fri Feb 10th cloudy not quite so cold as yesterday. I took the grain to mill and got chopt.

Sat Feb 11th clear and pleasant. I was thrashing out peas. Walter and Richard was shell-
ing corn.

Sun Feb 12th clear and pleasant.

Mon Feb 13th clear and warm the snow has melted a good deal today. we were cleaning up a load of grain to get chopt this fore noon. after noon was drawing up wood.

Broton February 1888.

Tue Feb 14th cloudy. soft and wet in the morning. commenced to snow about noon. cold and rough in the after noon. I filed the crosscut saw helped feed was about all I done to day.

Wed Feb 15th clear and very cold. 6 deg below zero this morning. Dickie froze his ears going to school. I was thrashing out peas to day. Walter attending the stock.

Thu Feb 16th clear and not so cold as yesterday. I was chopping wood part of the day.

Fri Feb 17th cloudy and soft. was sawing wood part of the fore noon. after noon took some grain to mill to get chopt.

Sat Feb 18th clear and warm. the roads getting sloppy. we were sawing wood this fore noon. after noon, I went after the chop feed.

Sun Feb 19th cloudy and soft rain in the evening.
