I feel much better of late and have been able to walk out several times, but can scarcely comprehend my own weakness. The ministers stable was raised last week, so I hope that little difficulty is surmounted.

Sunday March 30th

Had a severe relapse of headache a few days ago feel more helpless than ever, day cold and slight snow. It is just a month today since "Dea Kelly" was laid under the snow.

Monday March 31st

Day beautiful and clear. Boy drawing stones for wharf will finish tomorrow. I have all the while my eye in shortening wood.
