- Aug 17<sup>th</sup> Finished drawing grain off 1 acre. 1 load of mixed grain  $\frac{4}{5}$  of No 2 & 3 Date  
and  $\frac{1}{2}$  of loose rakings.
- 18 - Went over to George Lee for tea in the evening.
- 19 - Picked yellow Sugar plums nearly 4 small baskets.
- 21 - Finished drawing in oats 8  $\frac{1}{2}$  loads off centre East field  
and 9 loads off fields next Dalgells barn.
- 22 - Went to Paris in the evening to meet Dupuis on arrival from  
Blender.
- 23 - Started to plow 14 acre field for wheat.
- 25 - Bert Williamson came up for the day and took Harry home.
- 26 - Finished hoeing <sup>turnips</sup> manure and time. Tellanna had a little run & calf.
- 27 - Grandma & Grandpa Lee Ed & Vera Dupuis & family came over for the day.
- 28 - A very fine rain to day, which was very badly needed, the ground  
being almost too dry to plow. Satt up new corn - binder, but
- 29 - Drove Dray and the children home to Brantford in afternoon.
- 30 - Lewis first birthday and as it was Jean Johnsons birthday too  
they had a little party over there for them both.
- Sept 2<sup>nd</sup> Borrowed H. Cumberham's double plow to plow for wheat  
my son came to help with for a day.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Helped H. Wilson to thresh in the forenoon.
- 4<sup>th</sup> Finished plowing 14 acre field for wheat.
- 7 - Blasted 5 large stones in back 14 acre field.  
Fred Archibald came up for a little visit.
- 8 - We went to Alva Lee for Dinner & tea and to the Methodist S.S.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of
- 9 - Went to Simons threshing.
- 10 - Helped Johnsons to thresh in forenoon & Hartys in afternoon.
- 11 - Scott Bryer came to thresh, threshing 300 bush in one day.
