Island 5th Unfortunate Day very
fine Molly calved yesterday
Drew 6 Logs to the shore took
2 Logs from the Bush and went
to Lancaster took Back 220 Feet
21 Boards at stove wood very
fine and warm got the Horse shed
2 Sleighs passed up came from
the south-side Plushy on the ice
6th took 5 Logs from the shore
this Morning to Mill and 3 in the
afternoon took up 400 Boards from
to night 7th Raining fine Day
Went with 3 Logs took 744
Feet to Day got a Rat yesterday
Drew 8 Logs Out of the Bush to the
Bank at the upper side of the Island
