A very Fine Day Turned a cloudy
East Wind set 2 Lines caught the first
perch Thunder Lightning far off
Began to use the Tar-Barrel for feed
28th very Fine Day Eclipse visible
Sowed the New-Oats 2 Bushel
Sowed 4 Bushels of our own
Ploughing Harrowing Ditching Draining
Working at the Garden East Wind cool
New-Moon to Day Wrote a Letter
To Dan concerning John Camerons
But did not send it off a Jug
with a Raft aground Below the
Lighthouse Put the Separator in the
Granary Just corn up what was planted
First 29th Royal Oak Day or oak-
-Apple Day Fine E Wind planted
Potatoes over at the Maple Tree
in hills Harrowing the Potatoes and
corn Began to put in the North West
Frame Window took up the Boat to dry
under covered with the Letter
3 Eels 3 suckers

JAMES Cameron Island 30th May 1900
Fine Seander went to sow New
Oats Stanley taken away stones
from around the House East Wind
changed to West Mr Hugh Fraser
here for Sand Jona and I took
a Load of Wood from the Bay
Night-hawks came 31st Fine Working
at the Building taking these odd
kind of Stones and Crockery and
Bones down to the River Rained
some showers Last Night Rain
and Thunder this evening an Indian
passed up close to shore putting in
the glass and clabording Heavy Rain Thunder
1st of June The Glorious 1st of June
Vicksburg Birth Day 1878 a Fine Day
East Wind Jona and I went to
fish got 10 3 Indians passed in a
Boat Looking for Peter Squire
halted the cattle CASHAN went
down Went to fish got 3 Rained
- Heavy all night
