43 Lots of Yaghts going now
23rd Fine Windy John Mc Came
24th St Bartholomew Day
Fine cut some Brush Puddled
the Beans at Lower Point
Stanley has a soar Throat
Lewis here for Butter Randolph
Came through the night 25th
Fine Fixed the Roof and Pipe
put in the Marsh Hay
and some coals of oats
Livina and Fona went to
Stanley Island with Eggs Bought
Matches The Columbian Down
with Big Load of Passengers Bought
100 of Flour a Tub of Butter
to Do Bought 2 Boats came
genting on the north side

James Cameron Island 26th August 1856
Fine West Wind Seander and Randolph
went to Cut Marsh Hay on Round Island
Black Horse Island or Sheep Island
It has all these names 2 Boats
fishing out Besides the Rushes
one Boat upset and they got
a Ducking Fixing my Boat
Took in the Bealls Sorting
the chickens for to sell them
crows at the apples 27th Fine
a Pic Nic at Hamiltons Island
for the church Fishing Party
Got a Bun from the Men
from Cornwall thats Fentel
on the north side Rain last
night 28th Fine Randolph Seander
Mowing on Black Horse or Round Island
Lewis and Mary Ann here she is
sowing on the sowing Machine
Lewis a Dollar for the Hay that
Cornwall senters went off
to Day Lewis to Butter and
Randolph crossed to night
