4 From now on, until 1st June I did not write any thing.

5 There was a message came to us at 7 A. M. to go to John's place and I got there at 8.30. Birdie was unconscious. She died about 2.20 P. M. Fear and fear got there, so did Murdy.

6 I came home with Murdy.

7 Birdie was buried today. Amy Hall 1/2 day 30

8 I am not well. Katie Christie is here.

9 I am in bed all day. Katie comes here from school.

10 Got Dr. Robertson. After examining me said I had congestion of the lungs. 90 sugar 25

15 Cousin Mary came

14 Sowed carrots parsnips onions beets. Amy Hall sowed them. seeds 30⁰⁰. Am 30

18 Chickens came out
