 Finished 10m Drove me home got 2 Bags
 Potatoes Mrs Camy departed 20th not well
 Fine 21st at Wood 22nd Drawing Wood 23rd

 17th 18th Misses Hutton's Birth Day 1855
 19th crossed Bought of Mr Parry 2 lbs of Pease
 1 1/2 yds of Calico 15 cent pipe 12 crackers 2
 stop at Hammetton 20th came from Hammetton
 2 Bags of Potatoes 21st Fine W. H. Munroe
 here Bought the White Bull 10 Dollars Allen
 and Rebecca came and Hugh to take the Bull
 22nd Washington B Day a Fine Day Sun & foggy
 here 23rd cutting in the Bush cold 24th
 cold 25th Fine St. Matthias Day chopping
