- 25: X: fine warm: home up at 7<sup>30</sup> chore. Both & Olive walk to Faulkners & Back Church at 8. Rev. Williamson preach.
- 26: fine cool. home Mary up at 5<sup>30</sup> Both board up walk to Cedar Mills at 6<sup>45</sup> C.P.R. to Toronto. I out for walk. Mrs Lou Coalter & Blanche & Claude here for dinner. at Lyons for tea.
- 27: fine warm: up at 6<sup>30</sup> chore: W. Sleep. Dinner Mable deposit \$20<sup>00</sup> in bank J. H. C. Cheque for August, and get \$20<sup>00</sup> out for us, warm
- 28: cloudy rain: home up at 6<sup>30</sup> chore read & sleep: Mary ~~4~~<sup>44</sup> years old today
- 29: fine cool: home up at 6<sup>30</sup> chore. read Sleep: Mrs McEadden go. S. S. at 6<sup>30</sup> to Toronto tonight, cool.
- 30: cloudy fine: home up at 6<sup>30</sup> chore read sleep: Olive go S. S. at 6<sup>30</sup> to Toronto tonight: Willie in chat.
- 31: cloudy rain: home up at 6<sup>30</sup> chore read Sleep: chore.
- Sep 1: X: fine cool: home up at 7<sup>30</sup> chore, read sleep: Memorial service in English Church at 7<sup>30</sup> for Albert Walker Ken Kennedy Preach. Big crowd. Rev Williamson Preach at 7<sup>30</sup> in Methodist Church, Russell. to Belmont in car with Wm Bibles. today, cool
- 2: fine cool, home up at 6<sup>30</sup> chore Mary wash. I walk to angle crossing chat to Jas Scott on sidewalk.
- 3: cloudy rain fine warm: home chore up at 7. chore: Mable Pearl John start to school: Miss Owens teacher. got letter from J. H. C. from France dated the 4th of August, well then:
- 4: cloudy mild: home up at 6<sup>30</sup> chore Russell in bed all day W at table cool. Rain near all night
- 5: cloudy misty cool: home up at 6<sup>30</sup> chore: got letter from Chaplain Boyce dated France aug 11th: about J. H. C. wounded in left arm & right leg
