I went to Fairfax with the Rev Mr Casells he came here on yestodays Express the Rev Mr Trumbull ^{in the morning} preached

we drew 11 loads of ashes to the orchard

drew 8 loads of ashes (revised the orchard) and put 3 of them on the little field drew 5 loads of dung from Mr Rings & to be put them in the garden

drew 9 loads from Joseph Toxlers stable put them in the old haun field

Ad cultivated in the summer fallow in the Gnanogue him & Mr thrashed peas in the afternoon I mended Ad & Jimmie boats a very little rain to day the ground

I went to Gnanogue to Mill took 3 bags of wheat & 6 of peas got the peas ground for the hogs Mr drew potatoes in the garden potatoes is a poor crop Ad will be next morning

Rev Mr Caswell preached in the morning & Mr at night
