- 17 Got 1 lb tea 55 cts. Bell Morrison came in
in the evening. Tar & Jimmie went to some
kind of a party in the evening
- 18 Monday morning, Mr Calder of Lunenburg
preached here in St Andrews in the
morning and evening yesterday. His
text in the morning was 1st verse of
21st Chap Revelations, I cannot remem-
ber the evening text -
It began to thaw yesterday and we
will likely loose all the snow
- 20 Rain, and the snow is going fast -
- 21 I was at P. meeting the evening was very fine
We sold 'Patry' to Sandy McStrye on Friday
for 10.00, he paid 10. on Saturday, and 10. Yes
today. Pa paid 1/2 of Taxes on Saturday
- 22 Fine day, nice and warm
- 23 Another fine day
- 24 We sent 6 bush of wheat to mill, and got it

- 24 ~~Thursday~~ I had Mrs Corrie moping to day - 25
I sold rags to Smider 25 cts bought 1 tin pot with
copper bottom 1.00. paid 75 cts in cash 1.00
Bt - 1 corn broom at D M Kieic 22 cts 22
it looks like rain. Pa gave Pae 25 cts yesterday 25
Mrs Valky knitted 1 pair hose, and footed another pair
for Birdie 25 + 12 1/2 = 37.50. We sent the sheep 38
to Pigeon on Thursday
- 25 A fine bright day not one particle of snow
The East wind is cold but otherwise the
day is lovely. Mrs Mc Gillivray was in Mont-
real last week attending a meeting
- 26 Monday evening, This has been a very fine
day but toward evening it began to cloud
for rain, and it is now raining very
heavily
- 27 Baked today and began to wash in
the afternoon, and Miss Catherine McLean
of Lunenburg who is visiting at Murdie's
came to spend the evening
- 28 Finished my washing. Tar went to the Gore with
cousin Donie yesterday
- 29 It began to snow a little this evening.
- 30 St Andrews day, quite stormy and a good
deal of snow, I saw some sleighs on the
road and they appeared to run well.
All this month has been pretty fine quite
a good lot of sunshine
