We did inside work to-day cleaned up barn floor etc put caustic potash on horns of two calves
Mr Hoffmann son of Awar H. here to-day looking at Jess. Girls called on Mrs McKenzie in P.M then went down town got at Russell's 25 to dry goods, at Phillips olive oil 60. Wilbi went down at night went to St Andrews church meeting Mr Charl gave address and views of North west admittance 15cts

Cloudy sunshine fine day not very frosty.
We spread 5 loads manure on No 7 and put one load in heap with two dead pigs under it. Mr Sanderson here in A.M getting his D.S. book which we fixed up and I signed it as one of the auditors. I drove Mary down about 6 o'clock she got at Armstrongs groceries \$2.20 got refund at Phillips on olive oil got yesterday 25cts paid it out again for goods. I got at Mcennis on 1 gal coal oil 23 10cts separator oil 15cts 10
Mary went up I got supper down home then went to prayer meeting with James Caldwell then we finished auditing church books in J.H.'s office. Paid Mr Goss for game 55cts
Heard yesterday that Geo Henderson of N.West was killed in a way
