Stormy day snowing and blowing not very frosty. I went up to Alina Mand and Rhoda in sleigh got Roy Black to telephone to Nesbitt about the road. Willie drove up later Lucy in utter met me there then we put Lucy in sleigh in Rhoda's place and utter in sleigh came home by Elora. We got cheque

I got at Phillips Express orders for \$55.00 cost 25 ds which I sent to Canadian Engines for cutting box Willie deposited \$20.00 in I B I cleaned seed barley P.M. Willie drove Mary down. I got bad kick in leg with Lucy to-night.
