Sunday 7th Grear here had a Bottle of Grog
 kept all night Lashy at Phelps 8th Monday
 Lovelons Birth Day a year old to Day
 Drawing Wood for the house Grear went off
 George Bosell married to Day Putting
 ashes in the Bags a stormy Day snowing wind
 Blustering Day 9th Snowy Tuesday chopping
 some Lashy took Dinner Went to Salmon River 10th
 Lashy came at 10 o'clock Began to wash after Breakfast call it 2nd Day
 at the Black Oats a very cold Day Fanning 9 1/2 of Black Oats
 Chopping some Put the Dogs in the Barn a very cold Forenoon at 12
 changed warm in the afternoon 12th On you came talking
 (At Wednesday) ~~the~~ fortunate Day about chopping
 took us 3 nice pieces of Meat Lashy chopping
 all day Me Drawing Wood to the house 13th Lashy Chopping
 Went to Mr Harpers Bought 1/2 lb Tea 2 1/2 lb Tobacco 1/3 Soap a Bar 1/3 Treat 1/4th Stormy Weather seen Angus came
 working at Harpers 14th Sunday Valentines Day also stormy Day
 15th Cold Day Lashy chopping 1/2 Day I commenced to Draw for
 the first drawing 16th Lashy chopping all Day Dan Summers
 Laurie & Bob here Drawing Wood Stormy Time 17th a very Frost
 Day I think the coldest we had yet the cows nose bleed
 to Day 18th Killed Higgins Birth Day cut
 down a Big Basswood Tree for rails in the swamp
 Drawing Wood in the afternoon 19th Lashy chopping
 me Fixing my coat drew a few Loads to the Bank
 20th Drawing some I went to Mr Harpers Bought 1/2 Gal 1/3
 1/2 lb Tea 1/2 for Lashy 6 Sups 1/3 got the cloth 7 lb weight 8 1/2
 got the lend of the pot 2 Treat 1/3 Dan Summers came
 21st Sunday Mr Harpers here & Susie Lashy went to
 Norway

Mr Summers Cameron Island Feb 22nd 1864
 Dan Summers went to John Cameron to chop
 Me Drawing till 12 o'clock Lashy came I went to
 O Summers with my Ashes 4 1/2 Bushels to my
 account a Treat at Davids 1/4th went to Mr
 Harpers Grog started home 23rd Went to
 Dundee with the cloth turned Back Bill breaking
 his Oxen Bought of Mr Harpers 1 Barrel of Flour
 \$1.75 a treat 1/4th a Fine Day Drawing Wood to the Bank
 Lashy chopping 24th St. Mathias Drawing Wood Crows came
 a Fine Day 25th Drawing Wood Lashy cut down the Maple
 on the Pitt Point cows going to the Bush 26th helping
 Lashy to split in the afternoon 27th Laurie went to Salmon
 River Sep too followed her finished working at the ellipse
 splitting at Lashy to Harpers 1 Treat of Whiskey 1/4th salts
 1/2 treat 1/2 exchanging axes 1/4th Sunday 28th a lone Lashy
 taking Medicine 29th Last Day of the month Lashy & Laurie
 his axe. Went to Bosells for his Gun 1st March
 kind of a Fine Day some snow & cloudy snow through the
 night Mr Lashy wrought Lashy & I thons out all
 night 2nd Lashy at the troughs him & I finished them
 to Day 98 Troughs Laurie came Blustering to Day
 3rd Drawing the troughs to the woods Drew some
 of the Maple from the Pitt Point Lashy
 thrashing the Pease straw over got a Reck out of
 it Lashy chopping the Oak on the Bank crust
 Good Livinia Bad with the South Lake 4th Lashy to
 Mr Harpers To 1 Quart of High Wine 1/3 1/2 lb Tobacco 1/4 Tea
 1/2 lb cattle going to the Bush 5th Heard 13 Jack Ducks Corching
 the Maple 12 cords Lashy & 6th Sunday Dan Summers came Lashy
 to Bosells heard of Nicholas Farlander being Drawed
 and Donald Mc Dougalls Daughter being Perished
 7th Dan & Lashy to the Store Harpers Bought 1/2 lb crackers 1/2
 Whiskey Lashy Maving a Great fall of snow a Treat on my soul
