Fine sunny in a.m. looked like rain all p.m. a heavy thunder storm and rain after six o'clock. Willie took down 10 bags chop Curless also 80 lbs wood to Steals @ 19 cts lb trade \$15.20. Brought up hay and by rake Frates Wood from station then went down for chop 30 cts. Eddie Nichol and I went around upper Nichol canvassing for increased subscriptions to general fund of church results averaged about \$3. wife family Jack Chapman brought load stove coal. Willie disked rape land. He got straw hat at Steals 15
