The funeral was a very large one the roads very bad. Henderson Black and Simble at funeral they represented Ferguson High school. Willie's expenses at Guelph fare 40. dinner 25. admittance 25. over cry 10 etc. Mary and mother drove down home Punch in buggy out one after
