Cloudy, hailing turned to frozen rain. around freezing point. I took back load manure from sheep house spent it on Fall wheat then Willie took 20 bushels oats to Curlins mill for J. J. Hamilton and went to Sherwood got garden seeds \$1.00 John plow \$2.25 sheep rack<sup>10</sup> and shafts of cart which cost 75 cts total \$4.10. In PM Willie went to seed fair and in evening he drove Bella and May over to Sam M. Kees for evening.

Cloudy some sunshine thawing considerable. We hauled back to J. J. 2 loads manure. Mother up in PM Gents drove her down they got clock mended at Marshalls 75 cts, sold to Mrs. M. Viner 5 lbs butter \$1.05 butter money from Pk Block Co \$13.98

In PM he took May down changed sleighs and brought up chop 155 took 7 1/2 bushels oats to Wilsons @ 41 cts \$3.07 tongue mending at Jemplins \$1.25 on after.
