 7 Jimmie sowed 13 bush. He went to Lincen and had a tooth filled. Got 1⁰⁰ Gave him 1⁰⁰. Whitford got 7 bush oats. Had Prue today 60. cts. Dan Campbell, Glen, buried
 8 Fine day. I did not go to church. Donald Roy's wife came and stayed till preaching was out. Birdie went out to D. Roy's
