- Fri Jan 4<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool. I bought of beef Bures boy Albert Logan was buried this after noon
- Sat Jan 5<sup>th</sup> clear part of the day. Sarah was here cleaning house and cooking
- Sun Jan 6<sup>th</sup> a moderate winter day
- Mon Jan 7<sup>th</sup> clear part of the day the air sharp Mr Newcomb came over part of the after noon
- Tue Jan 8<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant. I went over to James Clark's and bought a pair of Spey <sup>spectacles</sup> and left glasses to fit in frames
- Wed Jan 9<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant not a cloud to be seen all day the road got sloppy Bilton was here part of the fore noon
- Thu Jan 10<sup>th</sup> cloudy and moderate. a prospect of a storm. James Clark brought my Spectacles that had repaired.
- Fri Jan 11<sup>th</sup> clear and moderate. Sarah was here cleaning house and baking. Charley and Duncan Bolton came in a while this after noon. I got word this after noon that Old Mrs Lashbrook was dead. Dick was here and had dinner with us.

- Sat Septer 12<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool. Bilton was here Boilsons boy was here for the gun
- Sun Jan 13<sup>th</sup> cloudy and mild
- Mon Jan 14<sup>th</sup> cloudy and soft. Fred called in this fore noon he told me of Mrs Fred Smith's death
- Tue Jan 15<sup>th</sup> a snowing windy day
- Wed Jan 16<sup>th</sup> cloudy and moderate
- Thu Jan 17<sup>th</sup> cloudy about 3 inches of snow fell last night a stranger called here for James Clark Bilton was in a few minutes
- Fri Jan 18<sup>th</sup> cloudy and soft Sarah was here cleaning the house and baking
- Sat Jan 19<sup>th</sup> cloudy and mild the snow about all gone. James brought home the shot gun
- Sun Jan 20<sup>th</sup> cloudy part of the day but warm 60 deg above zero to night when I came from the Church
- Mon Jan 21<sup>th</sup> cloudy and the same as yesterday. Bilton was in part of the fore noon.
- Tue Jan 22<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool thirty deg colder than yesterday. no one in to day
- Wed Jan 23<sup>th</sup> cloudy in the morning after noon clear and pleasant. Gamet and the minister was in this after noon and Charley Mack
