Tuesday September 19<sup>th</sup>  
Up good and early this morning but it looked very rainy. Daddy and I took bath steam out. I rolled and harrowed. Mr. Jay came over and dished. We were at till about nine when it began to rain and we had to come in. It rained like fun for about an hour making the ground unfit to work on for a couple of days. I read till it stopped raining and then Daddy cut wood till noon and I took it in. This afternoon Dad went back and fixed the line fence between us and Watsons where the cows get over and then shoelled ditches. I cut the lawns cleaned out the stables and cut wood. There was somebody shooting over at Bonmaster's and the shot was rattling around on the barns where I was cutting wood so I thought I would get us they it would be like.
