- 16 Hired Henry, runs to the south west creek and began the plow below the house the soil pleased
  - 17 Henry plowing in the field below the house Henry plowed only half the day
  - 18 Rev. W. Nicholson preached at night. <sup>read Sermon</sup> <sup>with Thomas</sup> read
  - 19 George went to G. Whited & got the horses that had been front last night. no plowing
  - 20 we finished thrashing the peas with the cutting machine in the morning they then took the horse-pow & saw to Mr. Nicholson's saw his wife helped W. H. Cornett to Shingle in the afternoon fine day
  - 21 the boys finished sawing Mr. Nicholson's wood & sawed a little wood at Hilds hand front
  - 22 very little work it is thanksgiving day went & heard Rev. W. Fluston at the road Mr. Nicholson preached in the Methodist Church at seven o'clock rain & very dark
  - 23 George carried in the corn to the Barn
  - 24 finished the corn to plow in the field <sup>day</sup> front of the house the front is all out
  - 25 Rev. W. Nicholson preached this morning rain
  - 26 to plow I went to Don W. Hill and examined the concession allowance of road between this & a car front at 18 to lat 21 can get no road for rocks & ledges there I then laid out a road on the line between John Salimer & Mrs. W. Kellner the road is all on Salimer & 66 feet in width
  - 27 to finished plowing the field front of the house that finishes his plowing for the fall he has got all done he can do the ground is so wet he can do nothing in stable
  - 28 we all worked at the shoe then I got a fine <sup>2 right</sup> <sup>made done</sup>
  - 29 there was 5 of us worked at the shoe to day got all done & everything cleaned up H. George, W. H. & Bruce went out to the concession & put a shanty to the laborer when working there
  - 30 they killed hogs at the road George brought out one hog <sup>at night 1st day</sup>
