 5 Probably stormiest day this winter east wind frosty. Willie drove Mary down to Dr Armstrong in AM Jess in cutter. We did inside work Willie cleaned separation I made cool bin in cellar.

Thursday
 6 Very stormy day again some sunshine snowing dense snow flurries not so frosty. Willie drove down in morning with Jess in cutter to bring up mother but the drifts were so bad she decided not to come. We did inside work to-day

Friday
 7 Another stormy day sunshine very frosty. I took two sons Fama and Fleet over to Wilsons in PM. Willie drove mother up then down again evening. Mr Sars brought over two pair mitts he wanted for Willie and I. paid him 10cts for wood 10cts bread.

Saturday
 8 Sunny day exceedingly frosty. Willie took 1228 lbs pig chop down to Wilsons brought it up also 340 lbs frozen wheat chaffed 4.25
 120 lbs black dust 90 500 lbs flour @ 320 16.00
 also 45 lbs galvanized iron from foundry for bottom of iron boiler @ 4cts lbs \$1.80. In PM I drove him down with Jess in cutter changed bag flour since had been at it got bread at Jacksons 10cts tins at Armstrongs. I gave Lizzie Mc Donald ride up Willie stayed down for sale at lowtrays. Willie got up saw sharpened axe from 10cts
