3. Fine day. Thawing. I butted in oven. This is part day before our Communion Rev Mr Mc Keller of Martintown preached I did not go to church
4. Rev Mr Langell of Martintown preached. Pa and Jimmie went to Lancaster yesterday. Pa paid W Stewart, Barr, \$4.27, for some trouble with Major. Put at Campbells in Willis. 1 piece grey cotton 30 yds. 7cts = 2.10, 15 bleached cotton 3.00 Got at Lancaster 4 lbs steak 40cts, 4 of beef 24 64
5. Dull day. some rain, very few in church for Sunday of Sacrament. None from here but Archie Jimmie & Murdy. Offing for missions. Pa's off. 1.00
6. High wind all last night, calmed towards morning, Murdy went to the Green Valley. I washed.
7. Wind high all day. began to snow about 6. P. M. Pa went to see Kate, and found that Kenneth was seriously hurt, was driving to or from Lancaster when there was an accident happened and he was brought home unconscious. Dr Mavett was called. and Dr M Lumen sent for. and Dr P. from Montreal To 1/2 gal. B. Strap 22, 1 lb butter, 22 1/2 gal. lard oil 44
8. A good fall of snow, but it drifted it may help the roads more. Kenneth Robustown is much better. and is able to talk. He went home. There is a nurse for Kenny

11. Sold 32 doz 16 pr doz. Got 2 lb butter 1.00 per lb 2 Lamp chimneys 17. Put at J. L. 1 lb tea 25 2 spools thread 9cts I made some calls today. Francis (Simon is very sick.) Jack Mc Ken Willie Mc Phersons, Urquharts, Mr Watson had a wood bee drawing from the 4th
12. Communion at Hephzibah. Pa went left in night
13. Fine day. Murdy went North today hired D. Saddlers horse, Simon Fraser died today Jimmie got a knee in bot sleigh cart 1.30 1.30
14. I made a few calls. Jimmie drew wood
15. I Francis buried. D Mc Cormick had a sale of cattle and farm implements a heavy fall of snow at 1. P. M. then rain for over three hours, Sandy Bens wife was here for a short time
16. Murdy got home about 10 last night when we had rain last night they had snow in Montreal. The papers say 19 inches it stopped traffic for some time
17. Very fine bright day. The wind is cold the boys drew 6 cords of wood home To yeast 5 cts
18. Stormy all day. I butted in oven. snow falling & drifting. The boys drew two cords of wood (Stewart Ferguson cut 20 cords
