I went over to Mr. E. Parrish's early in the morning and bought a mow of hay for two hundred dollars. It was 36' x 22' x 8'. They plowed 512 cubic feet for a ton.

I delivered mail to the Bay and round the Townline with Queen and Dick and Kent delivered on the Club part with Fly and and the Cart. The day was fine and the roads are dry in places.

Wednesday April 5, 1922

I delivered mail on the whole route with Queen and Dick.

Kent Hyatt pruned apple trees.

The day was fine and the road is drying fast.

Thursday April 6, 1922

I delivered mail on the whole route today with Queen and Dick.

Kent pruned apples trees and plowed the garden. &c.

The day was a little cloudy but rather fine and the roads are drying fast and are being used.
