 Palm Sunday Sunday evening that
 Allen Camerons Child was taken a cross
 and left all night in the Presbyterian
 church on the front which was I think
 a very good idea 25th Lady Day Annunciation of Mary
 John Hamilton Charles Woss and Will Rose
 here Donald young a little M. Donells wife Departed
 this morning I Cropped to Summerstown
 the funeral of Allen Camerons Child
 to day the Priests and Bishops and the
 Unitarian Preacher in Williamstown this
 week speaking to a Mr Lachlan about
 a load of marsh hay to come tomorrow
 for it Bought of A J Baker 1 lb Powder
 3 lb shot 1/6 Box of Caps 10 cents seen the 2
 Herricks at Summers George and Ben
 turned a little soft this evening Nooker taking
 down his Potatoes to Peter Grants 26th
 soft to day Raining some put the marsh
 hay stack in the Barn Captain McLaughlin
 came for the hay got 1/2 ton gave me 6/3 and
 is going to leave the rest with A J Baker
 one of my feet very sore on the sole there is a
 corn and I put it out a piece of ice and it pains
 me most awful sore kind of looks like a thorn
 which is much needed froze some to night
 giving my Powder and shot 27th the funeral
 to day 28th Cropped William McKean came
 for a load of marsh hay gave me 2 Dollars
 for what he got Got 6/3 from A J Baker
 Captain McLaughlin left for me cropped again
 went to Mr Wills for a Pot Got a Ride up from
 Donald Angus Bought Basket 12/9 Denis treat 10
 Paid 10 minutes what I owed him 2/6 Butter 1/4
 to day

1877
 15th March
 that in the morning there on the shore I went
 to the beach and the morning began to rain the wind
 of both the sea and the shore was the day turned
 Friday evening to day 2 loads in now made
 the work of hay cutting the weeds around the potato

Mr Amos Emery Place March 25th 1872
 Good Friday Cropped to Summerstown
 got a Ride to Kenneths Place seen George
 Jerns coming and stop for him in at
 blinkers to finger bread 5 took a letter over
 for A J Baker to Devenen took 1 Back Paid
 25 cents to Donald Suple that I owed him
 got a bowl filled 10 cents got sweets from
 Mr David Baker for the children papers
 and a Book and 2 Lewis Harps for them
 to crackers 5 cents Bought a Oil Can for
 30 cents from A J Baker in to see Dunham
 Mills about the sugar Pot wanting
 8 lbs of sugar for the use of it it only
 hotels 6 Pails a Passenger come across with
 us Calvin Henry a Blacksmith winter coming
 on the Salmon River a fine day Bought
 of A J Baker 3 Quarts of Kerosene 3 1/2 cts 30th Cropped
 over got a Ride from John Hamilton got
 2 Bags from him to get Flour seen McLaughlin
 got 200 lb of Flour at the Mill on his order
 1/2 lb Tea 60 cents 30 cents for money got 15 Dollars
 American Money a Treat at Suples 15 cents took
 John Hamilton Horses and Load Home Tommy
 and I Helped them at Bells with a
 cow that could not get up seen Mrs
 Hopkins she went to Hamiltons took my
 supper there Robert Jack and John came
 A Smallinan took his Boiler and
 engine across to day Jim Hopkins helped
 them with the oreen where they got off the
 track on the ice
