4 Very hot said to be 93 in the shade done a little baking for the Pic Nic. tomorrow. Today had a calf today

5 Another hot day we were at the picnic near M. G. & J. move table. Jimmie & Murchy got chances. Bird did not go George McGilbray read an address & Sunday Union presented the money I do not know how much

6 I heard today that there was \$194⁰⁰. Yesterday being 2. B. M. of the front were gathering a purse for the family of the Rev. M. Kay. I gave \$3⁰⁰

7 Womens meeting at J. S. 27 persons present I gave 25

14 Got two lb tea at Willis 90cts Working at 25
pay, got 2 lb rice 1 lb chuse = 12-15

15 put in some hay. My Aunt Kate came here

16 rains last night. put in three loads hay
17 Mrs M Kay Hunt preached today. A large number referring in Montreal Aunt some lives lost I think it was on Thursday
